Eligibility

withdraw

How to Apply

Interested applicants are to complete the scholarship application form including contact details of two

referees. A non-refundable application fee of \$50 is required. However, if the application is not

successful the applicant will receive a \$50 credit to use towards any training-related fees at Papillon

Academy of Beauty Therapy.

Applications must be received no later than Monday 14th January.

All applications will be reviewed by the Academy Selection Panel made up of the Principal, Director,

Educator and Compliance Officer. A small number of applicants will be shortlisted and invited to an

interview from which the selection panel will make its final decision.

The successful applicant will be notified of the decision by mail. All decisions made by the Academy

Selection Panel concerning the scholarship shall be final.

Terms and Conditions

The scholarship recipient will not receive any money from Papillon Academy of Beauty Therapy. The

value of the scholarship will be recorded on the student's account with the total enrolment cost being

funded by Papillion Academy. Student is not required to pay back any fees in the event of

withdrawal/forfeiture.

The scholarship recipient must maintain satisfactory academic progress throughout their program in

order to retain their scholarship – accordingly an assessment of scholarship recipient academic progress

will take place at the end of each term or as required by the Academy Principal.

The scholarship recipient must attend the academy as per the timetable, Monday to Friday 9am-5pm.

The scholarship is not transferable to other students or institutes. Scholarship cannot be backdated.

A scholarship may be forfeited if a recipient:

• Changes their mode of study from full-time to part-time

Fails to attend class or special promotions

• Defers their program of study

Withdraws from study

• Fails to gain competencies across each individual course during their program

• Breaches Papillon Academy's policies

• Provides false or misleading information in their application.

A student who discontinues fulltime enrolment at the Academy during the school year must complete a

withdrawal form and will not be eligible to reapply.
