

Diploma of Beauty Therapy

The Diploma has been designed for those wishing to operate as a beauty therapist employing staff and managing a beauty salon.

The Diploma provides you with the skills and knowledge to work as a beauty therapist, providing a range of advanced beauty services/treatments to clients. It also enables the development of small business management skills required by the owner/manager of a beauty salon.

Qualification requirements:

To achieve a Diploma of Beauty Therapy a total of thirty three (33) units of competency must be completed. This comprises:

- Twenty three (23) core units, and
- Ten (10) elective units including eight (8) specialist electives
